Have a bachelor's degree in social work, counseling, public health or other related fields and a minimum of five years related experience in program development working with families and children; master's degree and a minimum of three years' experience with program management preferred. Good communication and consulting skills with a strong understanding of evaluation processes are required. Experience in leading groups is preferable. A commitment to parent training services is important.
