How does Volunteer Week work?

United Way of the Midlands collects volunteer project requests from schools and nonprofits in early winter. Projects open in early April for community volunteers to sign up to help.

Who can participate?

Organizations with a 501c3 nonprofit status are welcome to submit a project request to participate in United Way of the Midlands Volunteer Week.

Any company or individual can form volunteer teams and sign up for volunteer projects.

What kinds of projects take place during Volunteer Week?

There are so many different types of projects available during our Volunteer Week, including hands on project, small group projects, large group projects, virtual projects and everything in between! However, the most common type of work requested is general maintenance, cleaning, and landscaping.
